

RULE J5

**Employees of a fire and rescue authority other than regular firefighters -
supplementary**

Rule J5 mentions the other Parts of the FPS which apply to awards made under Rules J3 and J4 and explains that, apart from cover given under Rules J3 and J4, the FPS will not apply to a person who is not a regular firefighter.

This Rule was removed from the FPS with effect from 1 April 2006 when the Firefighters' Compensation Scheme was introduced.

Rule J5 mentions the other Parts of the FPS which apply to awards made under Rules J3 and J4 and explains that, apart from cover given under Rules J3 and J4, the FPS will not apply to a person who is not a regular firefighter.

Application of Rules

Rule J5(1) explains that in respect of an award under Rules J3 and J4, the following Parts and Rule apply (in addition to those mentioned within Rules J3 and J4) –

- Part A: Interpretation (e.g. the meaning of qualifying injury, etc.)
- Part H: Determination of questions and appeals
- Part L: Payment of awards and financial provisions
- Rule K5: Forfeiture

No other application of the FPS

Rule J5(2) states that, apart from the provisions set out in Rules J3 and J4 and mentioned in Rule J5(1), the FPS has no application to a person who is not a regular firefighter.

Points To Note

1. When an award is calculated as if you had been a regular firefighter, all references in the FPS to a regular firefighter which affect the payment of the award in question are taken as applying to you; references to a regular firefighter which have no bearing on the award in question would not apply to you.
